Mileage Reimbursement Rate Update

Effective January 1, 2009

Pursuant to C.G.S. §31-312(a):

Effective for actual travel expenses incurred on or after October 1, 2001, this statute increases the mileage reimbursement rate for all workers' compensation claimants who use their private motor vehicles to travel to medical appointments necessitated by their work-related injuries. This rate increase applies to all claimants, regardless of injury date, and coincides with the federal mileage reimbursement rate.

- For all travel expenses incurred **ON OR AFTER January 1, 2009**, the mileage reimbursement rate is 55.0 cents per mile.
